The Waters

Michael is an expert on fishing Lake Anna and the Tidal Potomac. He was the 2005 champion of the FLW Outdoors Potomac Stren and finished in 9th place in the 2007 Potomac Stren. The Boat

You will be fishing out of a beautiful blue and silver Ranger Comanche Z21 equipped with a 250 HP Mercury Outboard. This is a very comfortable rig and there will be ample space for your fishing tackle, food (no bananas), life preservers, clothes, etc. A 36 volt trolling motor provides maximum power and control while fishing. Lowrance GPS and sonar devices provide accurate navigation and aids to locating fish.

The Gear

Mike will provide the rods and the tackle you need to catch the big bass. Feel free to bring your own tackle if you want. Mike will provide your life preservers, drinks, and snacks. Each guest is responsible to bring or wear adequate clothing. Life preservers are required to be worn anytime the big motor is running and will be provided.
